1	273	.5(a)(2)	Identification. Procedures for intake screening to identify inmates who are known to be or observed to be mentally disabled and/or potentially suicidal and procedures for compliance with Code of Criminal Procedure Article 16.22 and referrals to available mental health officials While reviewing screening forms, it was determined that four (4) files did not contain documentation to verify that the magistrate was notified within 12 hours as required by Article 16.22 of the CCP.
2	273	.5(b)	Screening Instrument. An approved mental disabilities/suicide prevention screening instrument shall be completed immediately on all inmates admitted. While reviewing screening forms, it was determined that seven(7) files were not completed in its entirety. The jail staff failed to notate the time the screening took place, there were no comments when answering "yes" to questions, did not answer all of the questions on the form and they failed to document notifications to the magistrate, mental health, medical, and/or supervisor when required.
3	275	.1	Observation shall be performed at least every 30 minutes in areas where inmates known to be assaultive, potentially suicidal, mentally ill, or who have demonstrated bizarre behavior are confined. During the review of the 30 minute face-to-face observations, it was determined the jail staff exceeded the 30 minutes required by minimum standards by 1 minute up to 56 minutes.
