1	273	.5(a)(2)	<p>Procedures for intake screening to identify inmates who are known to be or observed to be mentally disabled and/or potentially suicidal and procedures for compliance with Code of Criminal Procedure Article 16.22 and referrals to available mental health officials</p> <p><b>The magistrate was being notified; however, the magistrate notification form was filled out incorrectly and did not advise the magistrate of the indicators documented on the mental health screening form. Also, the staff are not sending a copy of the screening form to the magistrate nor was the CCQ match reported as required by Article 16.22 of the CCP and minimum jail standards.</b></p>
2	273	.5(b)	<p>An approved mental disabilities/suicide prevention screening instrument shall be completed immediately on all inmates admitted.</p> <p><b>The Screening Form for Suicide and Medical/Mental/Developmental Impairments was not being filled out, in its entirety, as required by minimum jail standards.</b></p>
3	279	.1(2)	<p>Food preparation areas shall be inspected at least annually by health authorities and record kept for each inspection</p> <p><b>The last health inspection occurred on January 22, 2018. This places the inspection past due by 9 months.</b></p>
