To be completed on all newly admitted inmates prior to housing assignments to determine custody levels.</p> <p><b>During the inspection, it was determined that jail staff are incorrectly utilizing the Initial Custody Assessment form and inmates were incorrectly classified/housed.</b></p>
3	275	.2	<p>Personnel employed or appointed as jailers of county jails or personnel appointed, employed, or assigned to directly supervise jailers shall be licensed as per the requirements of the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement under the provisions of Part 7 of this title.</p> <p><b>While reviewing licensing, this inspector determined that a staff member, working on the jail floor since February 2020, did not have a valid TCOLE jailer license.</b></p>
