1	273	.6(3)	<p>A documented observation of the inmate shall be conducted every 15 minutes, at a minimum. The observations should include an assessment of the security of the restraints and the circulation to the extremities.</p> <p><b>During the inspection and after reviewing video evidence, it was determined that jail staff exceeded restraint observations from 1 minute up to 10 minutes. Restraint observations were an area of technical assistance from the 2019 annual inspection.</b></p>
2	275	.1	<p>Every facility shall have the appropriate number of jailers at the facility 24 hours each day. Facilities shall have an established procedure for documented, face-to-face observation of all inmates by jailers no less than once every 60 minutes.</p> <p><b>During the inspection and after reviewing video evidence, it was determined that jail staff exceeded the required face-to-face 60 minute observations from 1 minute up to 294 minutes.</b></p>
