



1	273	.6(3)	<p>A documented observation of the inmate shall be conducted every 15 minutes, at a minimum. The observations should include an assessment of the security of the restraints and the circulation to the extremities.</p> <p><b>Documentation reviewed revealed that jail staff exceeded the 15 minute observations from anywhere between 1 (one) to 23 (twenty-three) minutes.</b></p>
2	273	.5(a)(1)	<p>Training. Provisions for staff training (including frequency and duration) on the procedures for recognition, supervision, documentation, and handling of inmates who are mentally disabled and/or potentially suicidal. Supplemental training should be provided to those staff members responsible for intake screening.</p> <p><b>Documentation reviewed revealed that jail staff had not received four (4) hours of Suicide Prevention Training twice annually as detailed in the approved Goliad County Mental Disabilities/Suicide Prevention Operational Plan.</b></p>
