Personnel employed or appointed as jailers or personnel appointed, employed, or assigned to directly supervise jailers at facilities operated under vendor contract with a county or city shall be licensed as per the requirements of the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement under the provisions of Part 7 of this title.

During the review of staff licensing, it was determined that twenty-three (23) staff members appointed as temporary jailers were not registered for a basic licensing course on or before the 90th day after appointment as mandated by Texas Administrative Code Title 37, Part 7 217.1(g) and Texas Occupations Code 1701.310
